This is to certify that according to the Ministry of Science, Research and Technology of Iran, the grading system at Amirkabir University of Technology is as follows:

- The evaluation of students in each course is based on their attendance in course sessions, activities in the classroom, assignments, and the results of the mid-term and end-term examinations.
- Education in all universities of the country is credit-based system. Each educational programme consists of many courses which are usually provided during 3.5-4.5 years for bachelor degrees, 2-2.5 years for master degrees and 3.5-5.0 years for PhD degrees. Each educational year is comprised of two semesters. In a credit-based system, the value of each course is measured with the number of credits (units) in that course.
- Students in each course are evaluated by marks between 0 (minimum) and 20 (maximum).
- The minimum pass mark for bachelor, master and PhD courses is 10, 12 and 14 out of 20, respectively. A student who fails in any course is required to repeat it at the earliest opportunity.

The mark conversion table to ranking system is categorized as below:

Iranian Grading System	Grade Description	U.S. Grading Equivalent
16-20	4	A
14-15.9	3	B
12-13.9	2	C
10-11.9	1	D
0-9.9	0	F

The GPA of each semester is calculated by the sum of each course's mark multiplied by the credit of that course divided by the sum of the credits of that semester.

$$\text{GPA} = \frac{(\text{Credit} * \text{mark})_{\text{course 1}} + (\text{Credit} * \text{mark})_{\text{course 2}} + \dots + (\text{Credit} * \text{mark})_{\text{course n}}}{\text{Sum of all credits}}$$

- The GPA in any semester should not be less than 12 out of 20 for bachelor degrees, 14 out of 20 for master degrees, and 16 out of 20 for doctoral students; otherwise, the student registration will be conditional for the following semester.
